

## WDHS Student Parliament Funding Proposal: Guidelines (February 2024)

## **Eligibility**

- All student groups currently registered with Student Parliament and school staff are eligible to submit a funding proposal
- Current Parliament members may not submit a request on behalf of a student group, even if they are active members of the group
- Proposals must be specific and detailed
- All proposals must reflect and promote behavior that follows WDHS/HWDSB expectations and regulations
- The maximum proposal is limited to \$300. If a proposal exceeds \$300, please email <a href="mailto:ntidridg@hwdsb.on.ca">ntidridg@hwdsb.on.ca</a> or DM @wdhswarriors on Instagram for further discussions

Priority will be given to initiatives/activities/events that are:

- 1. New
- 2. Serving an under-represented or under-served population in the school
- 3. Primarily benefitting all/many WDHS students
- 4. Of significant educational or cultural value to the school community

Funding is not guaranteed. Parliament has the right to make decisions on full or partial funding based on budgetary restrictions and adherence to the parameters of the Guidelines. Funds are also limited, and late submissions may not result in funding.

## **Process**

- To register with Student Parliament, complete the Club Information Questionnaire. If it has already been completed within the current school year and the information is still up to date, re-registration is not required
- Parliament will deliberate and vote on the application during the first or second meeting after the submission of the application
- It is recommended that a representative of the application attend the meeting following the application to provide more information
- Applicants will be emailed once Parliament has reviewed their application
